

NATIONAL DATA PRIVACY AGREEMENT

Canva is a signatory of the National Data Privacy Agreement (“NDPA”). The NDPA is a model privacy agreement drafted by the Student Data Privacy Consortium, a collaboration of schools, districts, local authorities, states, US and international ministries of education, software vendors and consultants. Additionally, several states have signed onto the NDPA and included additional state-specific terms and conditions.

STATE LEVEL COMPLIANCE AND AGREEMENTS

Canva has either signed NDPA's or otherwise entered into agreements with the following states, which can be utilized by any school or district *within* the state. Canva complies with the California Student Online Personal Information Protection Act (SOPIPA), a law that protects the privacy and security of student data, and California Assembly Bill 1584 (“CB 1584”), a law that protects student records.

Connecticut

Canva has signed the Connecticut Student Data Privacy Pledge, certifying its compliance with Connecticut Gen. Stat. Ann § 10-234aa-dd, available in the [Connecticut LearnPlatform](#).

Illinois

Canva is compliant with the Illinois Student Online Personal Protection Act -105 ILCS 85 (SOPPA), which is the student data privacy law that regulates the use and processing of students' data by schools, the Illinois State Board of Education, and education technology vendors.

New York Education Law §2-d

Canva's policies and procedures are in substantial compliance with New York Education Law §2-d, and Canva agrees to the NY State model Parent's Bill of Rights. Canva has signed EdLaw2d Data Sharing Agreements with multiple New York districts. Canva has also signed a data protection agreement with Citi BOCES and it includes a Joinder Agreement, which permits other BOCES to sign on to the agreement.
